Follow the instructions accompanying each jingle

In came the doctor, (One more person jumps in)
In came the nurse, (One more person jumps in)
In came the lady with the alligator purse, (One more person jumps in)
Out went the doctor, (First person in jumps out)
Out went the nurse, (Second person in jumps out)
Out went the lady with the alligator purse. (Last person in jumps out)



The person left in, is the original jumper and the rope should continue to get faster until they lose their footing.

Say good night! (Jumper exits the rope and another begins)

When's your birthday?
